



THE ACADEMIC GRANT PROGRAM OF THE PARAPSYCHOLOGY FOUNDATION

The Parapsychology Foundation offers the following categories of scholarships and fellowships:

1. The Annual Charles T. and Judith A. Tart Research Grant of \$500, made possible through the generosity of Dr. and Mrs. Tart, is earmarked for a student who demonstrates a strong commitment to work within parapsychology. Applications may be made by undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate students with specific research plans. The deadline for receipt of the application is November 15th. The awardee is notified by December 1st.
2. The Annual Robert R. Coly Prize of \$1,000 was established to honor the Foundation's long-time Administrative Secretary and Treasurer. The Prize has been created to encourage incoming and current undergraduate college and university students who have sufficient interest in the field to understand its complexities and help conceptualize its future, even if they are not in a parapsychology degree program. Applications must be accompanied by one copy of the applicant's high school or college transcript, two letters of recommendations from individuals who know their abilities and their interest in the field, and an essay of 1000 to 1500 words that addresses the topic, "The Challenge of Parapsychology". The deadline for receipt of the application is November 15th. The prize recipient is notified by December 1st.

3. The Annual Eileen J. Garrett Scholarship of \$3,000 is designed to offer assistance to a student attending an accredited college or university who wishes to pursue the academic study of the science of parapsychology. Applicants must demonstrate a previous interest in parapsychology by including a sample of writings on the subject with the application form. Letters of reference are also required from three individuals who are familiar with the applicant's work and/or studies in parapsychology. The deadline for receipt of the application is July 15th. The awardee is notified by August 1st.
4. The Annual Frances P. Bolton Fellowship of \$3,000 is awarded to a person who obtained their Ph.D. on the basis of a dissertation/thesis which dealt with some aspect of parapsychological phenomena, and whose intent is to use the Fellowship to further write up and polish the data they amassed during the preparation of their doctoral dissertation/thesis. Applications **must** be accompanied by a copy of the doctoral dissertation/thesis for ultimate inclusion in the Foundation's Eileen J. Garrett Research Library. The deadline for receipt of the application and dissertation/thesis is February 15th. The awardee is notified by March 1st. It is expected that the successful applicant will also submit an article suitable for publication in the *International Journal of Parapsychology*.
5. The D. Scott Rogo Award for Parapsychological Literature of \$3,000 is awarded to an author working on a manuscript pertaining to the science of parapsychology. The Award was established in honor of the generosity of the late D. Scott Rogo, parapsychologist and prolific writer. To apply for the Award, an author must submit a brief synopsis of the proposed contents of the manuscript and a completed application form. The deadline for submission is April 15th, and the awardee is notified by May 1st.

The Annual Eileen J. Garrett Research Scholarship of \$3,000 is designed to offer assistance to a student attending an accredited college or university who wishes to pursue the academic study of the science of parapsychology. Funding is restricted to study, research, and experimentation in the field of parapsychology. It is **not** for general study nor is it for those who merely have a general interest in the subject matter.

Applicants **must** demonstrate a previous academic interest in parapsychology by including with the application form a sample of writings on the subject. Letters of reference are also required from three individuals who are familiar with the applicant's work and/or studies in parapsychology.

The deadline for submission of the application is July 15th. The scholarship winner will be notified by August 1st.
